

Must have 8 participants to offer the program.


Basketball Updates

5&6 grade basketball will begin in mid-January after the Junior High Season is completed.

3&4 grade co-ed basketball will tentatively start in early January with the possible exception of a few days in December depending on gym availability.

1st & 2nd grade basketball will begin on in early January.



Basketball Competitions Coming Up

Elk's Hoop Shoot - During the month of December students in grades three through eight have the opportunity to compete in the national Elk's Hoop Shoot Contest (foul shooting). Trophies will be awarded at the school for all divisions. Winners will advance to the district shoot-out in January at UMPI.

Hot Shots - During January & February we will participate in MRPA's Hot Shot competition for youth 9-18 years of age. It involves shooting from five "hot spots" marked on one end of the basketball court. This competition will test each contestants speed, shooting, dribbling & rebounding ability. Division winners will advance to the Regional Competition then advance to the MRPA Red Claws State Hot Shot Competition.
